2. All work must be original, done only by the exhibitor in the last two or three years, and not have been entered in any previous Salmon Arm Fair.
3. All paintings must be framed, complete with wire for hanging, or they will not be accepted. Pictures that are improperly framed or wired will not be hung due to the risk of harming other paintings and projects.
4. PLEASE be SENSIBLE when you bring in exhibits – i.e., NO wet paint, NO homemade vase that is spilling water all over, NO craft made out of melting chocolate etc... it is important that your exhibit not damage other exhibits.

Entries must apply nail art to a professional plastic nail tip, size 1 to 5. Entrant may use any materials to create original nail art including foil, striping tape, gem stones etc. Artwork must be hand crafted, not store-bought or decals. Each entrant may enter up to 3 nails in one class (give each nail a “name” on the Entry Form). Each plastic nail tip must be glued onto an orangewood stick or Popsicle stick.

LIVE KIDS' LEGO CHALLENGE

A live competition held Sunday afternoon at the Fair for kids ages 8 to 15. Kids provide their own LEGO. Competition is to promote original, creative thinking, good attitudes, and the ability to 'perform' in public. Lots of prizes.

Rules will be available at registration, from the Convenor, or from the Fair website.

Participants in the live competition should register as an exhibitor in the following class:

THIS YEARS' LEGO COMPETITIONS (classes 134-139) ARE ALL GOING TO BE A 'THEME CHALLENGE'. The Theme for this years' LEGO displays is going to be 'Agriculture' or 'The Harvest'. No matter what age you are, please build a LEGO display according to the above theme..ie, Farm display, build a tractor or other farm vehicle, etc.

Lego - Only Original Design - NOT from a kit or any part of a kit. Maximum base size 46 cm X 46 cm:

134. Lego Display - original design by a person 8 years old and under.
135. Lego Display - original design by a person ages 9 to 10.
136. Lego Display - original design by a person ages 11 to 12.
137. Lego Display - original design by a person ages 13 to 14.
138. Lego Display - original design by a person ages 15 to 18.

SALT BLOCK SCUPTURE

This is a novelty exhibit primarily for the livestock owners, however anyone who should happen to have an animal-sculptured salt block may enter. IMPORTANT: The sculpture MUST be done on a board about 36 cm X 36 cm and must be reasonably clean. The sculpture MUST have a TITLE printed clearly on a sign, and positioned across the front of the base. The title is very important for the judging.

Printing must be large, easy to read, and black or outlined in black. Entries are judged by PRINTERS who look for 'printability'. Entries MUST be framed, complete with a wire for hanging, or they will NOT be displayed. The winning entry will be used for the next year's Fall Fair book cover.
